

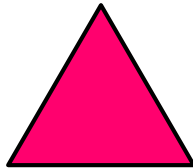

1. SHAPE:

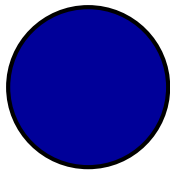
- The measurable, identifiable contours of an object

(Two-Dimensional)

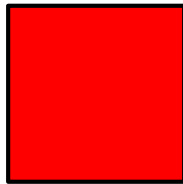
A. Triangle-

c. Square/Rectangle-

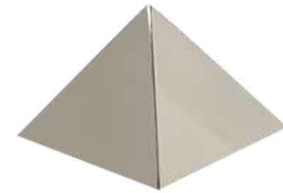


2. FORM:

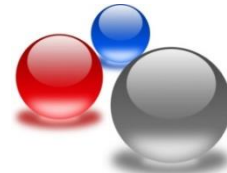
- Uses a shape and adds “substance”-All forms are made up of one or more of the basic shapes in various combinations.

(Three-Dimensional)

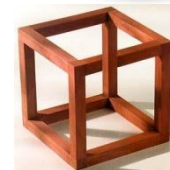
A. Pyramid-

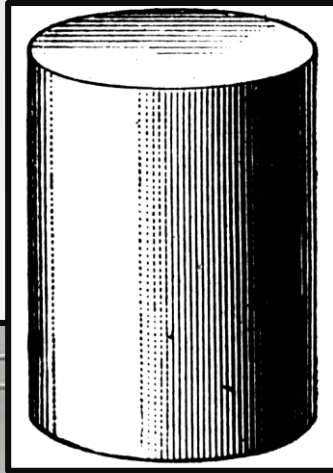

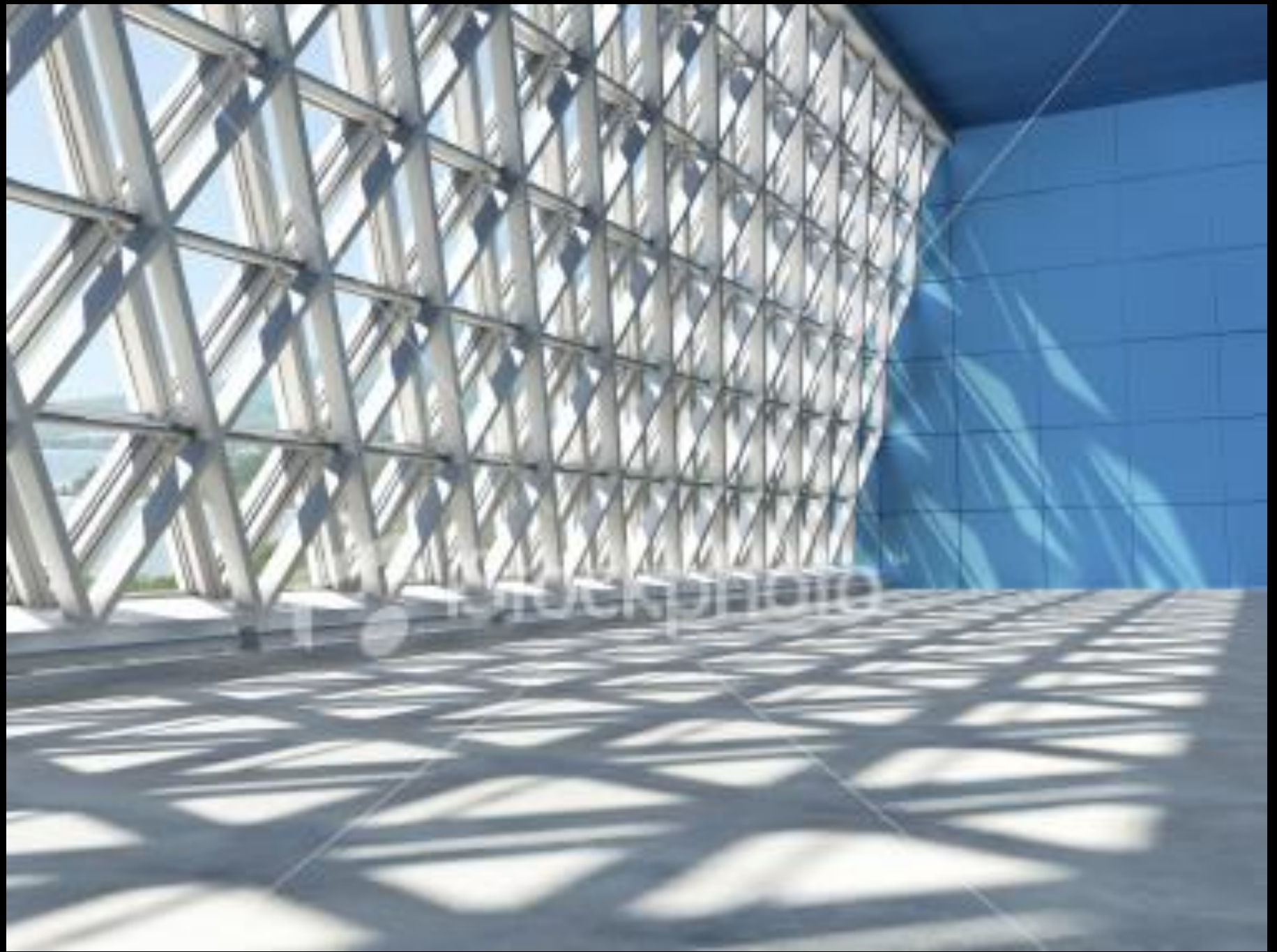
